Black Sheep is a soft, easy drinking Cabernet Sauvignon of medium structure showing dark cherry fruit, mint and sweet chocolate with hints of leafy greens and a long smooth finish.

The 2011 vintage shows the resilience of the Cabernet grape once again. The thick skin of this variety allowed it to withstand the harsh growing conditions of this vintage and exhibit true varietal character.

Winemaker Notes:

The strongest variety to come out of a difficult 2011 vintage. The 2011 Black Sheep delivers bold fruit flavours with depth and complexity unusual for such a young style.

Food Pairing:

This wine was created especially for more delicate flavored foods such as lamb, quail, veal, duck and in particular pasta dishes, a superb wine to serve with pizza.
